Design engineers for the UK's first Millenium Bridge - a timber footbridge over the A4 near Calne, Wiltshire, built as part of the National Cycle Network for pedal powered traffic and pedestrians - specified that it be constructed predominantly in glulam. The inclined suspension bridge manufactured by Cowley Structural Timberwork, a member of the Glued Laminated Timber Association, and designed by Mark Lovell Design Engineers, is one of eight Millennium Bridges which will form part of a UK network of safe and attractive routes for cyclists, walkers and wheelchair users. The 20-mile Route 4 section is funded by North Wiltshire District Council, Wiltshire County Council, Sustrans, the National Lottery and other organisations. The deck of the bridge, which was made in one unit, is cantilevered from the main arch on European redwood timber rocker beams, 400m square, via a system of stool support cables. In principle, it has the appearance of a counter-balanced mechanism provided by the canted arch frame and deck. Enquiry-No. 1000
